Mt Albert and Meola Creek

Description: A mix of level paths and steep paths/steps. Suitable for users of average fitness and mobility. May require boots in wet weather, running shoes suitable in dry weather. Caution: Muddy and slippery when wet.

To see: Volcano crater, boardwalk and water birds, reclaimed creek vegetation, Auckland City views, Waitemata Harbour views, glimpses of Manukau Harbour and the Waitakere Hills.

Time: approx. 60 minutes.

Parking: Wairere Ave off New North Road

Buses: Alberton Avenue, Mt Albert (stop 8222) Journey Planner—<u>http://www.maxx.co.nz</u> or catch a train to Mt Albert (Baldwin Ave).

Starting from the Carpark (Wairere Ave, off New North Road):

- 1. Cross New North Road at the pedestrian lights.
- 2. Turn left < along New North Road, then right > into Alberton Road
- 3. At the bend in the road, turn left < onto the boardwalk path (signposted Roy Clements Treeway)
- 4. Follow the path along the creek to Fergusson Reserve (also known as Kerr-Taylor Reserve)
- 5. Cross the reserve and take the second path on the left < (opposite the bridge and path that goes towards Mt Albert Grammar School) and turn right > into Haverstock Road
- 6. Turn right > into Euston Road.
- Turn right along Mt Albert Road and cross at the pedestrian lights, turn right >.
- 8. Turn left < Highland Road.
- 9. Turn right > into Vitner Terrace.
- 10. Cross Mount Royal Ave, turn left < then right > to enter Mt Albert-Owairaka Domain.
- 11. Follow the defined track until you reach the summit road at the dog exercise area/water reservoir.
- 12. Turn right > onto the summit road (divert to the left < to the trig station for view and return to summit road), continue up the hill
- 13. Follow the road to the exit, turn right > down the hill thru the gateway into Summit Drive.
- 14. Cross Mount Albert Rd, turn left <
- 15. Turn right > into Kitenui Avenue
- 16. Turn right > into Alexis Ave
- 17. Turn left < into Alberton Avenue and return to the start.
