## Proposed Western Springs Action Plan

- WLB commit to enhancing Significant Ecological Area, including rock forest, stream and wetland
  - Involve professional biodiversity and water sensitive design experts
  - Map park identify volcanic outcrops, soils of sedimentary
- Produce park values plan based on:
  - Ecological value and rarity a sense of place
  - Mana whenua focus, aligned with AUP
  - Amenity for playground and events
  - ... explain how the values were derived
- Prøduce ecological restoration plan
  - Finhance rare lava rock forest
  - Waiateao riparian and Wai Orēa lake side planting
  - Pest management and weed management
  - Investigate rare long fin cf short fin tuna/ eel
- Signs to include information about local lava, aquifer and rare rock forest
